- When opening an inspection chamber or manhole you must take the necessary safety precautions.
- 2. Lifting the manhole cover: this may take two people as it can be heavy.
- Once the manhole cover is lifted, determine the direction of flow. This can be determined by flushing a toilet in the property.
- 4. You will need to fit Non Return Valves to each of the flow pipes from the property.
- DO NOT install on the outlet of the chambers (where the water flows to) as this will cause a blockage. Only install NRV's on the chamber inlets.
- 6. Clean out the incoming pipes of any debris.
- Take the NRV out of the box, put on gloves and push the NRV up the pipe inlet mouth. Use pipe lubricant sparingly if required.
- 8. Make sure the valve is positioned correctly in the pipe, with the flap position downwards and the hinge pivot point horizontal.
- Ensure the locking mechanisms are unlocked for normal use

For maintenance, the NRV can be locked closed.
