



This allows for the maximum amount of light to enter the room below and gives the lantern a neat modern look.

Not only do Wendland Lanterns look stylish, they are also designed with many thermal features to help stop condensation. This feature is very important if the room below is to be used as a kitchen where changing heat levels can be a problem.

Clip-fit features and the unique ridgeLOCK mean that Wendland Lanterns are fast to fit and go together perfectly every time.

The U-Value of the flat skylight is just 1.2 and helps to avoid condensation, something that is very important in rooms such as kitchens or bathrooms where heat levels can change quickly.
